Context and purpose of your contribution

Data protection

It will be solely used for the purpose of contacting individuals in case clarifications are needed regarding their feedback or comments.

Only personal data that is relevant for the CEWASTE project public consultation process will be collected. No sensitive information will be collected. In line with the EU General Data Protection Regulation, you have the right to access information about the use of your personal data, as well as the right to rectify/amend, cancel or oppose the use of your personal data at any time during the period of research and storage of your data. The contact data collected will not be disclosed to companies or media without prior authorisation. The information is collected and stored on secure servers in a password protected file.
